RESOLUTION NO. 2011-45

WHEREAS, the increase in the size of farm equipment and the increased lengths of Semi-Tractor trailers has resulted in numerous requests for the widening of existing driveways to accommodate the increased size of farm equipment and Semi-Tractor Trailers; and

WHEREAS, the Boone County Board of Commissioners wish to establish a standard policy for the upgrading of those existing driveways for the purpose of ingress and egress off of County Roads; and

WHEREAS, driveways that qualify under this policy will be determined on a case by case basis; and

WHEREAS, those driveways that do not qualify under this policy shall be subject to the policy as stated in a Resolution dated the 6th day of January, 1976; specifically:

Boone County will not furnish any construction materials for driveways onto County Roads. All requests for driveways on to County Roads will be reviewed by the County Board as to location and materials to determine if the driveway will constitute traffic or water flow problems and the County Board may regulate the type of driveway to be installed if conditions warrant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Boone County Board of Commissioners that for driveways that qualify under this policy, the cost of material will be shared 50/50 by the County and the person/persons requesting the upgrade to the driveway, and the County will supply the labor for installation of the driveway upgrade.
